- Junior exhibitors will be expected to bench their own birds unless otherwise directed by the stewards. Juniors may exhibit in senior **or** junior sections on the day, but not in both.
- Prize money and trophies will be available at the Poultry Pavilion when the presentations take place at approximately 3:30pm.
