Rules and Regulations:

1. Approved helmets must be worn by all competitors. This is a rule of Victorian Agricultural Show Ltd. It is compulsory for everyone competing on a horse working, schooling or riding for any other reason at a show or in any area consider to be part of the showgrounds. (Rule applies to all VASL affiliated Agricultural Societies) Alexandra P & A Association is Affiliated with VASL.
2. Appropriate footwear must be worn by all competitors.
3. Riders must supply their own numbers. Numbers will be allocated on the day.
4. The judge's decision shall be final, in any class, it will be left to the judge discretion to award a first prize or to split or amalgamate classes.
5. The committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any event.
6. The ground stewards and committee have the power to evict horses not properly restrained whilst on the showgrounds.
7. All competitors exhibit entirely at their own risk.
8. Enter in Hunter classes or open (not in both).
9. Entries will not be accepted unless the entry form has been completed and signed by the exhibitor.
10. Do not jump jump's unless in the freshman's event.
11. No Stallion allowed in Rings 2 and 3
12. Please note A rider falling from their horse in a Riding class is not eligible to remount and continue in that class, but may continue to compete in other classes (but only if cleared as fit to continue by the first aid official).
13. Pony Club riders & Parents please note: Mounts must have two current pony club rallies to be eligible to compete in the pony club classes run under PVC Rules. You must present your cards to the steward before entering the class. If you do not present you card to the ring steward, you will not be allowed to ride in the pony club ring.
14. **Only horses entered in the show competing in classes are allowed on the showgrounds on show day.**

Definitions:

Novice: Not having won a novice class competing singularly at any agricultural show.

Local: resides within 25kms of the Alexandra Post Office.

Pony club is a grassroots organisation that work on educating our young riders in the art of riding and horse mastership. This showing series is designed to encourage members to work towards mastering the discipline of showing from presentation to ringcraft. All members are to work together and help each other always. There is to be only kind caring behaviour, encouragement, and absolutely no coaching from the sidelines from our NEZ community. Together we do better.

Pony club events to be conducted under current PCAV rules. Competitors must be financial members of PCAV. Pony club uniform including PCV helmet is required. Only PCV approved snaffle bits allowed. No Card, No ride.

This is a trial year for the showing series and we will slightly change and adjust rules if needed. All NEZ club members will be notified of any changes.

Additional NDESS Champion series rules for showing Only.

- All pony club members on a lead or needing adult assistance must enter the open age classes, all other classes are for the members that are independent in their riding and horse handling skills.
- To be eligible for the NDESS Championship Series in showing members must attend 3 of the NEZ NEDSS shows within the series.
- All riders and handlers must be a member of PCA through one of our Pony Clubs, including adults assisting (this can be in a club supporter capacity).
- Plaiting and clipping is optional and riders/ handler will not be penalized for having unplaited or unclipped horses.
- Horses and ponies must be presented in a snaffle bridle only inline with the PCV showing guidelines.
- Rings will not have more than 8 riders/ handlers at any one time. Rings that have more than 8 will be split into heats, then complete for overall places.
- All riders must have attended 2 rallies within 12 months to be eligible to compete in the NEDSS Showing series, cards must be presented at the show and checked.
- Riders complete at their age on the 1st July for that year. For example, if you are 7yo on the 1st of July you will ride in the under 8yo classes for the 2025 series.
- Placings are 1st to 4th at shows, placing are from 1st to 6th for the overall championship.
- The NEDSS scoring accumulates for each rider and horse combination.

Pony club events to be conducted under current PCAV rules. Competitors must be financial members of PCAV. Pony club uniform including PCV helmet is required.
